### **NSPS Membership Classifications:**

**Associate Member:** Any person who by employment is actively engaged in a program leading to a career in the profession of surveying.

**Life Member:** Any individual member who has been a Voting Member of NSPS for not less than 20 years and reached the age of 65, any member who has been a Voting Member for not less than 30 years and has reached the age of 60, or any Life Member of NSPS

**Member:** An individual is eligible to be a Regular Member if he or she is: (1) Licensed Member. An individual is eligible to be a Licensed Member if he or she is a person licensed to practice the profession of surveying, according to state or provincial statutes. (2a) A person practicing the profession of surveying, who has attained the professional qualifications, required and is classified as “Land Surveyor” or “Supervisory Land Surveyor,” according to series GS 1373 of the U.S. Office of Personnel Management; (2b) An academician holding a bachelor of science degree and the rank of assistant professor or higher and teaching surveying in a two or four year surveying program accredited by the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET) or the Canadian Accreditation Board (CAB) or approved by the appropriate State Land Registration Board; or (2c) A person practicing the profession of surveying, or teaching surveying, who has attained a minimum of ten years experience in responsible charge of surveying activities, or a combination of four years education and sufficient experience in responsible charge totaling ten years.

**NSPS Fellow:** By invitation only from NSPS Admissions Committee.

**Student:** Full time student at a post-secondary academic institution.
